



Felisberto Dinis Navalha
Governor of the Banco de Moçambique

Felisberto Dinis Navalha was born in Chimoio in 1971. He holds a Bachelor's degree in Economics (1996) and a Master's degree in Development Economics (2012), both from Eduardo Mondlane University. He is a PhD student in Economics at the Catholic University of Mozambique, on a programme offered in partnership with the School of Economics and Management of the University of Porto.

He joined the Banco de Moçambique in 1996, and was assigned to the Economic Research Department. From 2007 to 2011, he served as Assistant Director of the Macroeconomic Analysis Division, and in 2011, he was appointed Director of the Department.

In 2017, he was appointed a Board Member of the Banco de Moçambique and took charge of Administrative Services and Property Management. Subsequently, he assumed responsibility for Monetary Stability (2018-2019), Banking Operations, Currency Issuance and Payment Systems (2019 and 2022), and Financial Services and Human Resources (2019-2020).

In 2022, he left the Banco de Moçambique and joined the academic staff of the Faculty of Economics at Eduardo Mondlane University. During the same period, he provided consultancy services to public institutions, most notably the Mozambique Revenue Authority and Aeroportos de Moçambique.

On 1 September 2026, he was appointed Governor of the Banco de Moçambique.
